RESOLUTION NO. 04, 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS REGARDING COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT CHARGES

WHEREAS MCCLOUD COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT (hereinafter the "District") is a community services district duly organized and validly existing pursuant to the laws of the State of California, Government Code §61000 et seq., and,

WHEREAS the District is authorized that any charges and penalties may be collected on the tax roll in the same manner as property taxes after giving notice to the affected property owner at the time and place for a public hearing to consider any objections or protests to the District's statement of delinquent charges, and,

WHEREAS pursuant to Government Code §61115, the District mailed to the affected property owners a written Notice of Hearing for Filing of Report and Collection of Charges on Property Tax Role, notifying property owners of a public hearing before the Board of Directors of this District on July 13, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of hearing and making determinations on a report by the General Manager describing the amount of charges and delinquencies for FY 2019/2020 on the affected parcels,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the McCloud Community Services District that the report from the General Manager describing the amount of charges and delinquencies for FY 2019/2020 is attached hereto entitled Exhibit A and is hereby approved, received and filed; the Board hereby determines that the charges and delinquencies in the amount of \$2,068.64 shall be collected by the Siskiyou County Tax Collector on the Property Tax Roll in the same manner as property taxes; and that staff is hereby directed to file with the Siskiyou County Auditor a copy of this Resolution on or before August 7, 2020, whereby the County Auditor shall enter the amount of the delinquent charges as specified in this Resolution against each of the affected parcels of real property specified herein as they appear on the current assessment roll, and collect the charges and delinquencies in the same manner as property taxes.



Discussion/possible action regarding approval of Resolution No. 04, 2020 - A Resolution of the Board of Directors Regarding collection of Delinquent Charges.

Background:

The District routinely files liens against properties within the MCS D service area for collection of unpaid fees. This occurs once a property has become more than three months in arrears.

The District has the authority to request that the County Auditor include on a customer's tax roll the amount of delinquent fees owed the District, provided the Board gives its authority to do so.

There is currently one account which the General Manager is requesting that the Board approve seeking payment via the County Tax Roles. It is:
