ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING, PROHIBITING OBSTRUCTION OF RIGHTS OF WAY, AND PROVIDING FOR LIMITATIONS ON SPEED OF VEHICLES IN CERTAIN AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the McCloud Community Services District as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave any motor vehicle unattended in any public right of way or passage way or easement of ingress or egress regularly and habitually used by vehicles or pedestrians so as to obstruct, restrict and endanger the free use thereof by vehicles or pedestrians.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to drive, operate, maintain or use any automobile, truck, motorcycle or similar automotive equipment in , upon or along any unpaved alley way or service easement or to enter or leave there from while departing or entering upon any public street, at a speed in excess of ten (10) miles per hour. It shall similarly be unlawful to so operate, maintain or use a motor vehicle upon any paved or oiled right of way within the District the overall length of which right of way is less than five hundred (500) feet.

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct or block or barricade or interfere with free passage over, or leave any unattended motor vehicle, either partially or entirely, in or upon any public easement, cross or right of way, whether paved or unpaved, after due notice by any law or public officer of the District that said action or activity or act constitutes an obstruction of such easement or crossway or right of way and an interference with the public right to free and unobstructed use thereof. (This section was amended to include the wording shown herein on March 11, 1969.)

<u>Section 4</u>: The violation of any provision herein shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable by fine up the five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment of up to six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

<u>Section 5</u>: The above and foregoing ordinance is hereby designated to be an emergency ordinance to be and become fully effective July 16, 1968, in accordance with the resolution of July 9, 1968.
