service remains on Mondays, and businesses are allocated to Tuesdays and Fridays. Jerry is very punctual, so **please have your can accessible at 7 a.m.**

If your business would like to have a larger dumpster or be picked up twice a week, please contact the District.

Please make sure that your garbage can is not overflowing (the lid should be able to close). Excess trash bags will not be picked up without having a Prepaid Extra Refuse tag attached to the bag.



Extra Refuse tags are available at the District office for \$2.50 each.

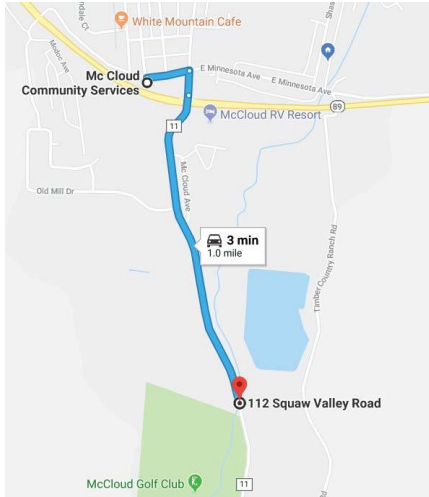
For District clients having problems with out of district dumpers, the District is offering laminated "No Outside Dumping" notices that can be adhered to your can or dumpster.

GREEN WASTE

In case you missed our last newsletter, the MCS D Green Waste Disposal Facility has moved to Squaw Valley Road. It is approximately 1-mile south

of the District office, on the East side of the road, just north of the Golf Course.

What is considered "Green" waste?

Green Waste accepted by the District is biodegradable yard and garden waste such as:

- Grass, shrub and tree trimmings.
- Pinecones and needles.
- Leaves, branches, flowers and weeds.

FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION

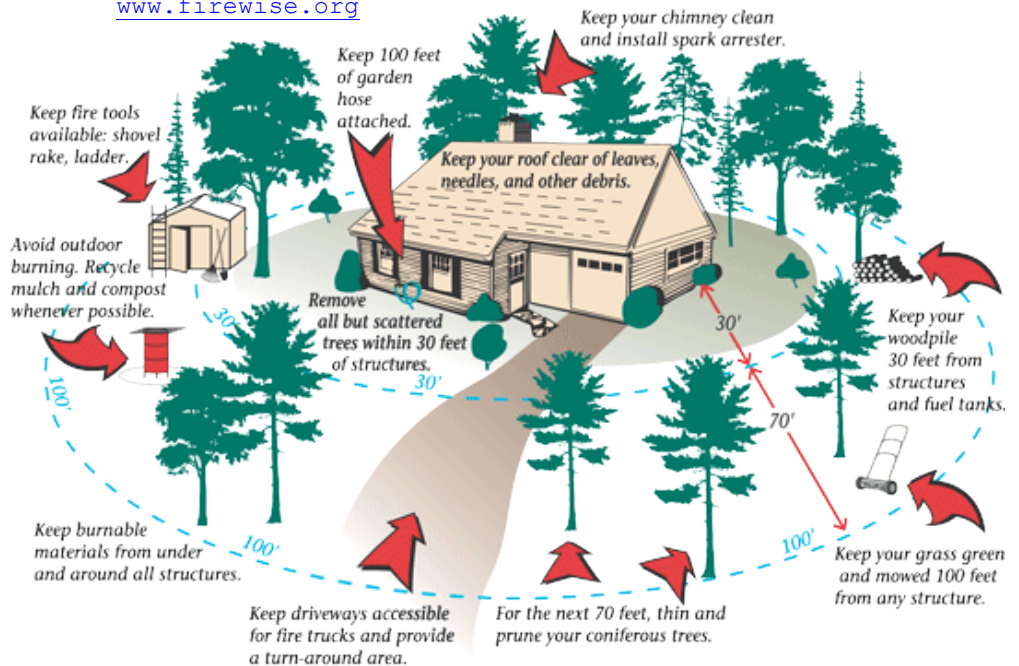
Fire season has hit northern California hard, and unfortunately, the Carr Fire tragedy in Redding serves as a stark reminder of the dangers of wildfire.
