**3410.10 Definitions: Shared Water Connections**

A secondary water service connection installed in the original McCloud water system from the District water main to the first valve serving the outside water hose bib(s) or faucets of a single parcel and/or two adjoining parcels.

**3410.11** All shared outside water connections will be shut off every fall after October 15th and turned on every spring by May 30th by District personnel.

**3410.12** No new shared water connections shall be installed. All existing shared water connections shall be abandoned by the District upon installation of a new or replacement water service meter box or at such other time as determined by the District to maintain a safe and efficient operation of the water system.

**3410.20 Private water plumbing**

All existing private water plumbing connected to such abandoned shared water connections shall be connected to their private water service at the discretion and expense of the property owner.

**3410.30 Access to Water Mains**

District personnel has the right of access to any premises that are served water from the District's water system. District personnel has access, at all reasonable times, to all parts of the water distribution system for the purpose of inspection or sampling related to maintenance of water quality. The District shall have the right to install and maintain on the user's property, and within the public right-of-way such devices as are necessary to conduct water sampling or metering operations.

**3410.40** This policy coincides with Ordinance 27.
